What is the classroom carer program?

The classroom carer program is a partnership between educators and volunteer parents and carers to share information with their class community to support engagement and communication between the classroom and home.

What does a classroom carer do?

We know that knowledge empowers families to continue learning at home, so classroom carers work with teachers to share information about what's been happening in the classroom, upcoming events and any other news that might be useful to your class community.

You might send an email to families once a week, fortnight or month - it's up to you. It's about sharing knowledge and building community so if want to help teachers and families connect sign up to be a classroom carer in 2020!

Who can be a classroom carer?

Any parent or carer can volunteer to be the classroom carer for their child's class. Our aim is to have a classroom carer for each class so if you're interested, chat to your teacher to find out how you can help!
